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# What is an adiZone?

- An adiZone is a 25m<sup>2</sup> multi-sports facility designed in the shape of the London 2012 Olympic logo to create a sporting legacy
- The facility includes a large outdoor gym, basketball and football area, climbing wall, tennis wall and a freestyle area for aerobics, dance and martial arts etc.
- It is fully inclusive with accessible ramps and equipment designed to be suitable for people with visual impairments or learning disabilities
- the adiZone has been designed and sponsored by adidas working with the Department for Children Schools and Families and the Great Outdoor Gym Company

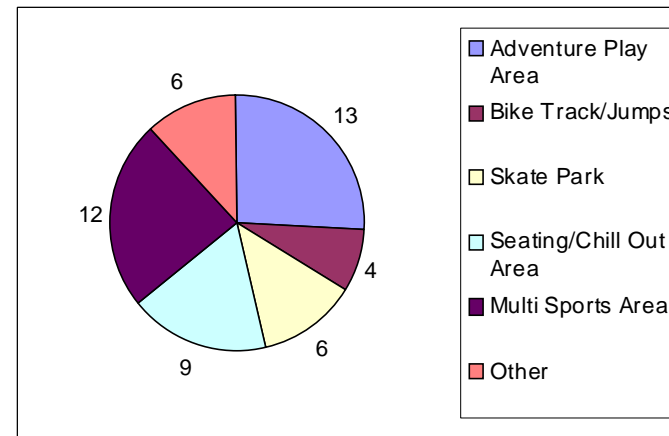
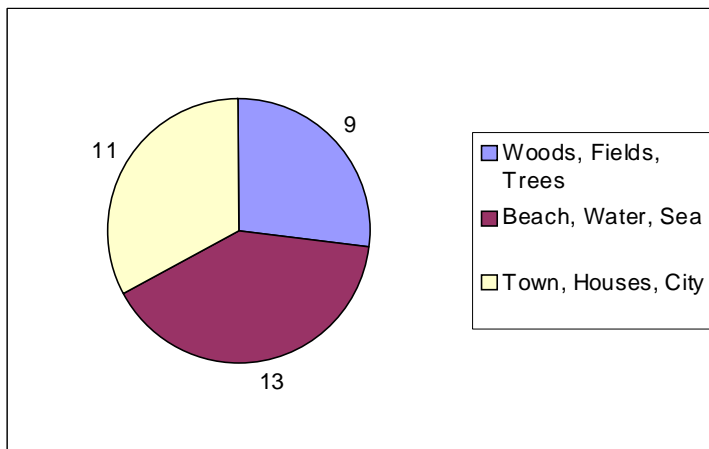
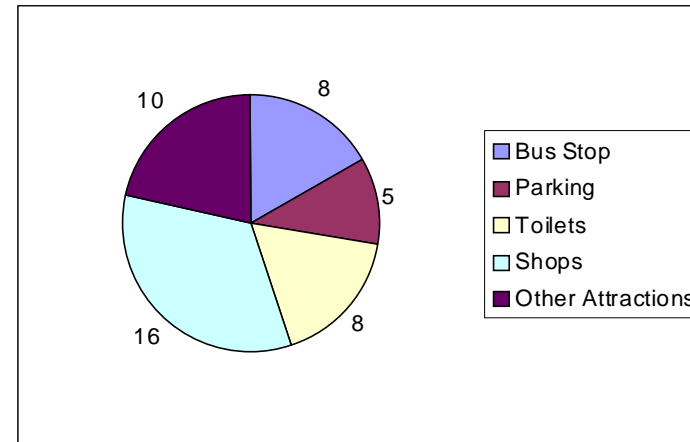
Havant Borough Council has raised funds for this project from a number of internal and external sources, these include:

## Funding Criteria:

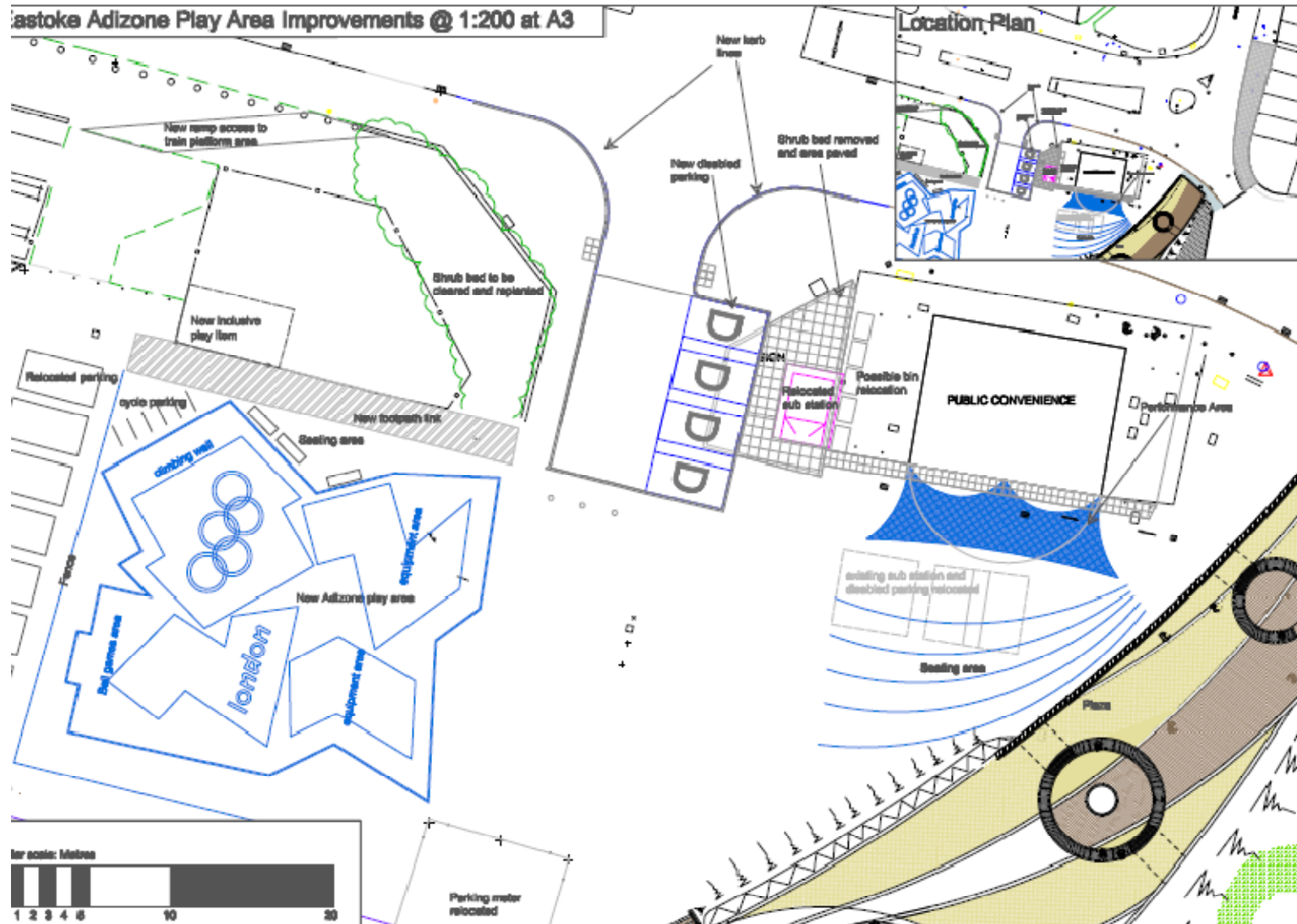
- consultation with children and young people with disabilities to determine their requirements
